

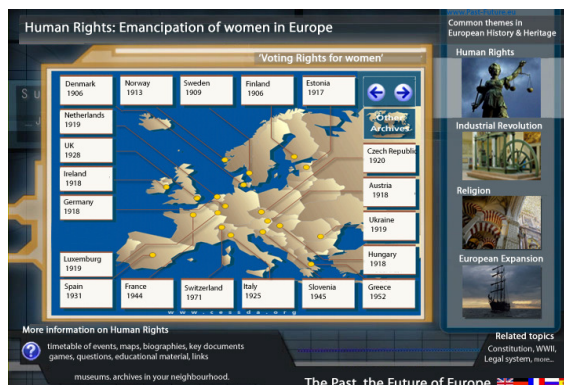
EUROGEO connects to EUROCLIO

Karl Donert attended a meeting of the EUROCLIO network (European History Teachers Association) and associated European partners to discuss a new project concerning exploring European history and heritage. The aim is to provide a resource which can be used to help educators in secondary schools to teach about European history and heritage from multiple perspectives.

The three-year project “**Past: the future of Europe**” has been funded by the European Commission under Comenius in the Lifelong Learning Programme and EUROGEO are one of the partners.

A Web tool will be developed to provide a common access point for educators in History, Heritage and Geography who would like to teach about Europe. These educators are often limited in the time and resources to find good educational material. A wealth of material has been developed already, but it is fragmented and of varying quality but educators have difficulties to find the right material. This online database will help them in their search. All registered users will be

notified as soon as a new educational package is available. Teacher training activities will help educators to modernize and use ICT in their lessons.



The four themes which are likely to be under development over the lifetime of the project are People on the Move, Rights and Responsibilities, Life and Leisure and War and Peace,
